  - b. (1) Bombers: Five Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack GUN POSITIONS IN GENOA AREA (44° 23'N, 08° 58'E); time at Target 1100B to 1140B. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack GUN POSITIONS IN MARSEILLES AREA (43° 18'N, 05° 23'E); time at Target 1135B. Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack GUN POSITIONS IN SETE AREA (43° 24'N, 03° 42'E); time at Target 1100B. Four Gps, B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack GUN POSITIONS IN MARSEILLES AREA (43° 18'N, 05° 23'E); time at Target 1110B. Eighth Air Force bomber now at 5th Wg bases will attack TOULOUSE/FRANCAZAL AIRDROME INSTALLATIONS and then return to their bases in ENGLAND.
