b. (1) Bombers: Two Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack DISPERSAL AREAS OF NIS AIRDROME (43° 20'N, 21° 52'E); target time 0850B. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack OIL TARGETS IN PLOESTI AREA; KP time 0930B. Four Gps, B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack OIL TARGETS IN PLOESTI AREA; KP time 1030B. 55th Wg Stand Down

(2) Escort: Four Gps fighters will provide close escort for 47th Wg, 49th and 304th Wgs on penetration, withdrawal and over target. Fighters will also provide top offensive cover for 47th Wg over the target. One Gp fighters will provide target and withdrawal cover for 5th Wg.

2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG and 484th BG will attack OIL TARGETS IN PLOESTI AREA on 17 August 1944. This is Plan "A".

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 461st and 484th BGs will line rendezvous behind 451st BG when 451st BG flies over CANDELA on a TC of 71° at 0720B. Lead Gp will depart between 304th and 55th Wg assembly area. (1) Three Gps load 500# RDX fused .1 nose and .025 tail. (2) PFF A/C lead all units - employment SOP. (3) Lead attack units of Gps load three (3) cartons Window. Dispensing will begin two (2) minutes before IP and continue at the rate of four (4) units every twenty (20) seconds until clear of flak. (4) Gps will go into outside echelon at Key Point. (5) Altitude at Adriatic Yugoslavia Coast 12,000 ft. (6) Five oil target are assigned for attack as primary targets. They are listed in order of priority with target number prefixed:

- (1) ASTRA ROMANA (44° 55'N, 26° 02'E).
- (2) UNIREA SPERANZA (44° 55'N, 26° 04'E).
- (3) XENIA (44° 57'N, 25° 59'E).
- (4) DACIA (44° 56'N, 26° 03'E).
- (5) ROMANA AMERICANA (44° 56'N, 26° 05'E).

(7) Three P-38 reconnaissance A/C will cover PLOESTI AREA in three periods. The first A/C will contact the 47^{th} Wg leader between 0930B and 0935B and between 0945B and 0950B. The second A/C will contact the 49^{th} Wg leader between 1000B and 1005B and between 1015B and 1020B. The third A/C will contact the 304th Wg leader between 1030B and 1035B and between 1045B and 1050B. Channel "A" will be used. Information transmitted will include direction and force of surface wind and smoke, and assigned number of target or targets which can be attacked visually. Wg leader will decide which target he will attack on the basis of this information and take up proper heading to respective IP. In the event contact is not established with the reconnaissance A/C, Wg leader will attack first alternate target assigned employing proper axis of attack. On receipt of this information from the recon A/C the Combat Wq Commander will announce over VHF Channel "B" his decision as to which target is to be attacked, by using the prefixed numbers assigned the targets. The route from the KP to target will be at the discretion of the combat Wg Commander and other Gps will follow the lead Gp to the target.
