- 1. a. See latest Intelligence Summaries and Annex "A".
 - b. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will destroy BLECHHAMMER SOUTH OIL RFY; KP time 0918A. Four 47th Wg, will destroy SARAJEVO WEST M/Y (43-51N, 18-22E), ZENICA RR BRIDGE (44-12N, 17-55E) and DOBOJ RR BRIDGE (44-08N, 18-08E); Four Gps B-24s each 55th Wg and 304th Wgs will destroy BLECHHAMMER SOUTH OIL RFY; KP times 55th Wg-0933A. 304th Wg-0953A.
 - (2) Escort: 15th Ftr. Cmd. will provide escort and target cover for bomber formation attacking BLECHHAMMER.
- 2. Normal effort, B-24s (28 A/C per Gp) each 451st BG, 461st BG, 484th BG will destroy BLECHHAMMER SOUTH OIL REFINERY (50-18N, 16-15E) on 20 November 1944. This is Plan "A".

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 484th BG and 451st BG will line rendezvous behind 461st BG when the 461st BG flies over BOVINO on a TC of 332° at 0853A. Rendezvous Altitudes 6,000, 7,000, and 8,000 ft.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: See Para. 1. B. (2) To be furnished later. WING FORMATION: Staggered column of Gps stepped up.

AIR FORCE FORMATION: Close column of Wgs in order 5th-55th-49th-304th.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: 461st BG lead-484th BG-451st BG.

ROUTE OUT: Base to KP to TP #1 to TP #2 to TP #3 to IP to target.

KEY POINT: VIS (43-51N, 15-31E) Base altitude 15,000 ft at 0922A.

- SECOND ALTERNATE TARGET: MORAVSNA OSTRAVA M/Y (49-51N, 18-16E). IP: WIGSTADTL (49-47N, 17-45E). Axis of attack: 79° . Rally left off target. Bombing altitude: 23,000, 24,000, 25,000 ft. Area to be bombed: 461st and 484th BGs- R/S-20, 451st BG-0-16/17 on target chart 15-15-NA. Target elevation: 711 ft.
- THIRD ALTERNATE TARGET: ZILINA M/Y (49-14N, 18-44E). IP: VSETIN (49-20N, 18-00E). Axis of attack: 102°. Rally right off target. Bombing altitude: 22,000, 23,000, 24,000 ft. Area to be bombed: MPI 461st and 484th- 7¾ Horizontal, 3 Vertical; 451st- 7 1/3 Horizontal, 6½ Vertical on MBC 15-43. Target elevation: 1128 ft.

- FIFTH ALTERNATE TARGET: LUNDENBURG M/Y (49-46N, 16-54E). IP: MY JAVA (48-45N, 17-34E). Axis of attack: 271°. Rally slight right off target. Bombing altitude: 20,000, 21,000, 22,000 ft. Area to be bombed: All Gps MPI 4 Horizontal and 3¾ Vertical on MBC 15-33. Target elevation: 521 ft.
 - 3. x. (1) All Gps load 500# RDX fused .1 nose and mixed .01 and .025 tail with 2 bombs per A/C fused for long delays of 6 to 72 hours.
 - (2) Gps will be at bombing altitude and go into left Echelon five
 - (5) minutes before IP.
 - (3) PFF A/C will lead all units. Employment SOP. This is a planned PFF mission
 - (4) Combat Wing Commander will fly as close behind 55th Wg as possible in order to reduce flak losses at target.
