- 1. a. See latest Intelligence Summaries and Annex "A".
 - b. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will destroy MUNICH EAST and WEST M/Y, time at KP 1108A. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg will destroy FERRARA R/R BRIDGE (44-54N, 11-37E) and VERONA LOCO REPAIR SHOPS (45-26N, 10-59E); target time approximately 1200a. Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will destroy MUNICH EAST and WEST M/Y; time at KP 1058A. Four Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will destroy MUNICH EAST and WEST M/Y; time at KP 1040A.
 - (2) Escort: 15th Ftr Cmd will provide target cover for Air Force Formation attacking MUNICH, and will conduct a fighter sweep in the PO VALLEY to cover the withdrawal of the Air Force Formation from MUNICH. 15th Ftr Cmd will provide Chaff dispensing A/C for lead of 304th Wg on each axis of attack.
- 2. Maximum effort B-24s (36 A/C per Gp) each 451st BG, 461st BG, 484th BG will attack MUNICH EAST and WEST M/Y (48-09N, 11-30E) on 22 November 1944. This is Plan Able.

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 461st BG and 484th BG will line rendezvous behind the 451st BG when the 451st BG flies over BOVINO at 0845A on a TC of 332°. Rendezvous altitudes 5,000, 6,000, and 7,000 feet. FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: To be furnished later. WING FORMATION: Staggered column of Gps stepped up. AIR FORCE FORMATION: Close column of Wqs in order 304th- 49th- 55th- and 5th Was. ORDER OF FLIGHT: 451st BG lead, 461st BG and 484th BG. ROUTE OUT: Base to TP #1 to KP to TP #2 to TP #3 to IP then split into two columns: 451st and 461st BGs from TP #3 to TP #4 to IP to Target; 484th BG from TP #3 to TP #5 to IP to Target. This is a planned PFF mission (4) The Wg will divide into two attack waves with the 451st and 461st BGs attacking the West M/Y and the 484th BG attacking the East M/Y. The route assigned after the split are designed to bring the two attack waves over the targets simultaneously and thus reduce the effectiveness of the flak defenses. (5) After bombs away, the combat wing commander will contact the group leader of the 484th BG and will attempt to reform the Wg for the flight back to the bases. 4. No Change.

Dispensing will begin three (3) minutes before IP and continue at the rate of three (3) bundles every twenty (20) seconds until clear of flak.
