- 1. a. See Latest Intelligence Summaries and Annex "A".
 - b. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack BRESCIA M/Y (45° 33'N, 10° 13'E) and BRESCIA FIAT PLANT; time at KP 0945B. Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack OIL STORAGE at PORTO MARGHERA (45° 28'N, 12° 15'E); time at KP 0955B. Four Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack OIL STORAGE at TRIESTE (45° 38'N, 13° 46'E) and FIUME (45° 19'N, 14° 28'E); time at KP 1005B. 47th Wg and Azon Force stand down.
 - (2) Escort: Fighters will provide penetration, target and withdrawal cover for individual Wgs.
- 2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG and 484th BG will attack SUBMARINES at TOULON (43 $^{\circ}$ 06'N, 05 $^{\circ}$ 59'E) on 11 July 1944. This is Plan "A".
- FIRST ALTERNATE TARGET: THEOULE RR BRIDGES (43° 32'N, 06° 56'E). Axis of attack: 100° TC. Rally: Very sharp right. Bombing Altitude: 484th BG 20,000; 451st BG 21,000 ft; 461st BG 22,000. Area to be bombed: Center of impact L-8/9. Target Chart 6-85-NA. Target Elevation: Sea level.
- SECOND ALTERNATE TARGET: VAR RIVER BRIDGE (43° 40'N, 07° 12'E). Axis of attack: 110° TC. Rally: Right and then left. Bombing Altitude: 484th BG 20,000; 451st BG 21,000 ft; 461st BG 22,000. Area to be bombed: All Gps center impact at E-11. Target Chart 6-77-NA. Target Elevation: 50 ft.
- BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 484th BG will be in rendezvous rectangle from 0847B until 0907B. 451st BG and 461st BG will follow SOP to rendezvous with lead Gp. Lead Gp will enter rectangle at CANDELA and depart from BOVINO making 1½ turns around rectangle. 484th will be at 5,000 ft; 451st BG at 6,000 ft; 461st 7,000 ft.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: See Para. 1. B. (2). To be furnished later. WING FORMATION: Staggered column of Gps stepped up.

AIR FORCE FORMATION: None for 49th Wg.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: 484th BG lead - 451st BG - 461st BG.

ROUTE OUT: Base to Key Point to TP #1 to TP #2 to IP to Target.

KEY POINT: (42° 23' N, 08° 43' E). Base altitude 13,000 ft at 1115B.
