 - b. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack PLOESTI XENIA OIL REFINERIES (44° 57'N, 26° 01'E); time at KP 0908B. Three Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack TARGOVISTE TANK FARM and DOICESTI/CREDITUL MINIER OIL REFINERY (44° 55'N, 16° 03'E); time at KP 0923B. Three Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack BUCHAREST MOGOSAIA OIL STORAGE (44° 29'N, 26° 04'E); time at KP 0933B. 55th Wg stand down.
 - (2) Escort: Maximum fighters will provide penetration, target and withdrawal cover for bomber formation and chaff dispensing units for PLOESTI bomber formation.
- 2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG and 484th BG will attack BUCHAREST PRAHOVA OIL REFINERY (44° 28'N, 26° 03'E) on 31 July 1944. This is Plan "A".

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 484th BG will fly over CANDELA at 0855B enroute to KP. 461st BG and 451st will line rendezvous behind 484th BG near CANDELA. The Wg will depart between 304th Wg and 55th Wg areas. Rendezvous altitudes: 484 - 8,000; 461 - 9,000; 451 - 10,000.
