 - b. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack VERONA MAIN M/Y (45° 27'N, 11° 00'E), BERGAMO STEEL WORKS (45° 37'N, 09° 40'E) and AVISO VIADUCT (46° 10'N, 11° 08'E); time at KP 0846B. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack TAGLIAMENTO CARSARSA RR BRIDGE (45° 52'N, 13° 50'E) and LATISANO RR BRIDGE (45° 45'N, 12° 59'E); time at KP 0851B. Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack PORTO MARGHERA OIL STORAGE (45° 27'N, 12° 25'E); time at KP 0911B. Four Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack TRIESTE NORTH REFINERY (45° 40'N, 13° 48'E); time at KP 0901B.

(2) Escort: Fighters will provide penetration, target, and withdrawal cover for each Wg. Penetration cover will begin approximately 50 miles after KP.

2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG and 484th BG will attack AVIANO OIL AND GASOLINE STORAGE (46° 01'N, 12° 38'E) on 6 July 1944. This is Plan "A".

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 484th BG will be in rendezvous rectangle from 0755B until 0810B. 451st BG and 461st BG will follow SOP to rendezvous with lead Gp. Lead Gp will enter rectangle at CANDELA, go around rectabgle 1½ times and depart from BOVINO vis CASALNUOVO. Rendezvous altitudes: 484th BG will be at 7,000 ft; 451st - 8,000 ft; 461st - 9,000 ft.
