- 1. a. See Latest Intelligence Summaries and Annex "A".
 - b. (1) Bombers: Five Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack BUCHAREST M/Y; time at KP 0906B. Four Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack BUCHAREST M/Y; time at KP 0940B. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack BUCHAREST M/Y; time at KP 0920B. One Gp B-17s, 483rd BG, 5th Wg will attack BELGRADE PANCEVO RR Bridge; time at KP 0953B. Two Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack BUCHAREST Railway Repair Shops; time at KP 0930B.
 - (2) Escort: One Gp Fighters will give close escort for 483rd BG. Four Gps Fighters will give general cover to the Air Force Formation on penetration, maximum cover over target and withdrawal.
- 2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG, 484th BG will attack BUCHAREST M/Y on 7 May 1944. This is Plan "A".

FIRST ALTERNATE TARGET: Bomb Industrial Center of BUCHAREST on ETA. LAST RESORT TARGET: Three M/Ys of CRAIDA and NIS.

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 484th BG will line rendezvous with 451st BG over BOVINO when 451st BG flies over on a TC of 68 degrees at 0856B.

461st BG will line rendezvous behind 484th BG over CASTELLUCIO at 0859B. 451st BG and 484th BG will be flying on a TC of 68 degrees. Altitude: 451st BG 5,000 ft; 484th BG 6,000 ft; 461st BG 7,000 ft.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: See Para. 1. b. (2).

WING FORMATION: Staggered column of Gps stepped up.

AIR FORCE FORMATION: Left echelon of Wgs, 5th Wg lead- 47th Wg- 55th Wg- 304th Wg- 49th Wg.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: 451st BG lead- 484th BG- 461st BG.

ROUTE OUT: Base to KP to TP #1 to TP #2 to IP to Target.

KEY POINT: BUDVA (42 deg 17 min N, 18 deg 51 min E) Base altitude 14,000 ft at 0950B.

TURN POINT #1: 42 deg 40 min N, 19 deg 10 min E.

TURN POINT #2: PEVENISCA (44 deg 52 min N, 22 deg 24 min E).

TURN POINT #3: 44 deg 40 min N, 23 deg 03 min E.

INTERVALOMETER SETTING: 451st BG-150 ft; 484th BG- 100 ft. 461st BG- 90 ft.

BOMBING ALTITUDE: 451st BG - 20,000 ft; 484th BG - 21,000 ft; 461st BG - 22,000 ft).

TARGET ELEVATION: Primary 300 ft. CRAIDVA-approx. 210 ft. NIS-610 ft.

RALLY: Right off Target turning inside RUSCHUCK and GIURGIU.

ROUTE BACK: Target to TP #3 to TP #1 to KP to Base.

TARGET TIME: 1140B.

 - (2) Three Gps load 500 # GO .1 sec nose with mixed .01 sec and .025 sec tail fusings.
