 - b. (1) Bombers: Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack PORTO SAN STEFANO and ORBETELLO MOLE; time at KP 1252B. Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack PIOMBINO Harbor, roads and M/Y; time at KP 1232B.

(2) Escort: Fighters will provide escort for three Wgs attacking West Coast of Italy and will conduct strafing attacks on GHEDI and VILLAFRANCO A/Ds.

2. Normal effort B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG, and 484th BG and will attack PORTO FERRAJO Harbor on 17 May 1944. This is Plan "D".
