b. (1) Bombers: Five Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack LYONS RENISSIEUX M/Y; time at KP 1220B. 47th Wg, Same as Plan "B". Four Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack GIVORS and AMHERIEN M/Y; time at KP 1210B. 304th Wg, Same as Plan "B".

(2) Escort: Escort will be provided for all bombers except those attacking MONFALCONE. 49th Wg will rendezvous with escort at IP. Other Wgs attacking French M/Y will rendezvous with fighters at LA CALIFORNIA near CANNES. Same escort and fighter call signs as Plan "B".

2. Normal effort each 451st BG, 461st BG, and 484th BG, will attack and destroy CARNOULES M/Y on 25 May 1944. This is Plan "C".

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 461st BG will line rendezvous behind the 451st BG over CASTELLUCCIO on a TC of 245 degrees at 0917B. 484th BG will line rendezvous behind 451st and 461st Gps over BOVINO on a TC of 270 degrees at 0922B. 451st BG will be at 5,000 ft; 461st BG will be at 6,000 ft; 484th at 7,000 ft or above overcast. FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: See Para. 1. B. (2). WING FORMATION: Staggered column of Gps stepped up. AIR FORCE FORMATION: Column of Wgs, 49th Wg lead - 55th Wg - 5th Wg. ORDER OF FLIGHT: 451st BG lead - 461st BG - 484th BG. ROUTE OUT: Base to Turn Point #1 to Key Point to IP to Target. KEY POINT: CANARI (42 deg 50 min N, 09 deg 18 min E) at 1120B at 15,000 ft.
