- 1. a. See Latest Intelligence Summaries and Annex "A".
 - b. (1) Bombers: Two Gps B-17s, 5th Wg, will attack XENIA OIL REFINERY; time at KP 0807B. Four Gps B-24s, 47th Wg, will attack ROMANO AMERICANO OIL REFINERY; time at KP 0733B. Three Gps B-24s, 55th Wg, will attack DACIA ROMANO and BEDEVENTA OIL REFINERIES; time at KP 0753B. Four Gps B-24s, 304th Wg, will attack UNCOA SPERANZA OIL REFINERIES; time at KP 0743B. All targets are in PLOESTI area.
 - (2) Escort: Five Gps will furnish penetration, target and withdrawal cover.
- 2. Normal effort B-24s each 461st BG, 484th BG, and 451st BG, will attack CONCORDIA VEGA OIL REFINERIES on 31 May 1944. This is Plan "A".
