OPERATIONS ORDER #228, Plan Able for 31 October 1944.

TARGET: PODGORICA TROOP CONCENTRATIONS.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: 461st BG lead, 484th BG and 451st BG.

EFFORT: 28 A/C per Gp.

RENDEZVOUS TIME AND ALTITUDE: Rendezvous rectangle from 1214A to 1234A at 12,000, 13,000 and 14,000 ft. 461st will enter and depart from CANDELA.

ROUTE OUT: Base to IP (42-07N, 18-46E) via CANOSA.

KEY POINT TIME AND ALTITUDE: None.

AREA TO BE BOMBED: All Gps MPI H-17/18 on Target Chart 8-11-NA.

BOMBING ALTITUDE: (461st- 19,000), (484th- 20,000), (451st- 21,000).

TARGET TIME: 1330A.

ROUTE BACK (INCLUDING RALLY): Rally left to OSJECENICA (43-42N, 18-40E) to Base.

ALTERNATE TARGETS: None. No bombs will be jettisoned or dropped in YUGOSLAVIA OR ALBANIA.

BOMB LOAD: 500#RDX fused .1 nose and .01 tail.

PPF: Optional.

VHF CALL SIGNS: (461st, "Airslug 41"), (484th, "Airslug 42"), (451st, "Airslug 43").

FLIGHTER CALL SIGN: No escort.

WX RECON: None.

RECALL IDENTIFICATION CODEWORD: "Frontier".

COMBAT WING COMMANDER: Lt. Col. Lawhon and Major Goree.
