B. (1) Bombers: Six Gps B-17s 5th Wg will attack STEYER-DIAMLER PUNCH AND STEYWAFFEN WALZLAGER WERK TANK WORKS. Four B-24s 47th Wg will attack ST. VALENTINE TANK WKS. Four Gps B-24s 55th Wg will attack LETTON BB PLANT NEAR STEYR and BOGLER WERK FACTORY AT WAIDHOFFEN. Four Gps B-24s 304th Wg will frag A/C and destroy INSTALLATIONS ON HORSCHING A/D.

(2) ESCORT: NONE FOR THE 49TH WG.

2.18 B-24s each 451st BG, 461st BG, 484th BG will conduct SUPPLY MISSION TO BRON A/D. LYON, FRANCE (L/M-13/14 on BRCH 6-47-NA) on 22 September 1944.
