1. ENEMY SITUATION.

a. FLAK

- (1) PORTO MARGHERA: No change. See Intelligence Annex No. 121, 10 July 1944.
- (2) MSTRE: No change. Sec Intelligence Annex No. 121, 10 July 1944.
- b. ENEMY AIRCRAFT. Intelligence Annex Fifteenth Air Force estimates enemy capable of 70--75 sorties against all formations attacking in North ADRIATIC area, but suggests reduced effort, since these e/a may be committed against Tactical Air Force and will be divided between formations attacking East and West ADRIATIC targets, with not more than 25--30 sorties against each.
- c. SIGNIFICANCE OF TARGET. Changed aiming point is designed to hit refined stocks instead of crude. See Intelligence Annex No. 121, 10 July 1944, par. l.c.

2. FRIENDLY SITUATION.

- a. Coordination of this attack is as follows:
- (1) 5th wing, 4 Groups, attacks LATISANO, CASARSA, PENZANO Bridges and AVISIO Viaduct.
- (2) 47th Wing, 4 Groups, attacks BRESCIA East and West M/Y's.
- (3) 304th Wing, 4 Groups, attacks TRIESTE and FIUME 0/R's.

b. The 306th Fighter Wing, 4 Groups, provides general cover for individual Bombardment Wings.

c. PHOTO INTELLIGENCE.

- a. Maximum effort of all available K-3B, K-17, and K-22 type aircraft cameras will be married. At least six cameras will have twelve inch cones, one will have a six inch cone, and the remaining camaras will have twenty four inch cones. All cameras will be operated at a two second interval.
- b. The Photographic Officer will brief all cameramen in conjunction with the briefing of the aerial gunners to insure successful operation of all cameras.
- c. Sufficient negatives will be printed to insure maximum photographic coverage as the bomb pattern develops.
