Wing Rendezvous: 460 lead over SPINAZZOLA on course at 0813B.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: To be signalled later.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: Individual Wings. 55th Wing (460-485-465).

ROUTE OUT: SPINAZZOIA to MELFI to (4144N 1213E) to Key Point PAIAZZO POINT (4223N 0832E) to (4321N 0642E) to MANOSCUE (4349N 0547E) to IP to Target. Cross French coast at 17000'. Last Point to start climb to Bombing Altitude: MANOSOUE. Key Point Time: 1035B at 12000 feet.
