BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: Group Rendezvous: 465th and 464th line rendezvous from ANDRIA to CANOSA at 7000 and 8000 feet. 464th falling in behind 465th in 465th area prior to rendezvous. 465th over ANDRIA at 0655B.

485th rendezvous in normal rendezvous area at 9000 feet approaching ALTAMURA from SANTERAMO IN COLLE and over ALTAMURA at 0901D.

Wing Rendezvous: 465th lead over SPINAZZOLA on course at 0710B.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: To be signalled later.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: Right echelon of Wings: 304th, 55th (465-464-485), 49th, 5th.

ROUTE OUT: SPINAZZOIA to Key Point RAGUSA (42 31N, 18 22E) to KRUSEVAC (43 35N, 21 20E) to CARACAL (44 08N, 24 21E) to PRUNDUL

(44 05N, 26 14E) to HOTARELE (44 11N, 26 21E) to IP to target. Last Point to start climb to Bombing Altitude - URATAR-NICA (43 47N, 22 19E). Key Point Time: 0800B at 14000 feet.

485 Group attack PLOESTI/STANDARD Q/R using MPI shown on inclosed target chart.

465 and 464 groups attack PLOESTI ASTRO/ROMANO 0/R using MPI as shown on attached target chart.

All Groups load 10 - 500# GP fused .1 nose and .025 tail. Intervalometer Settings: All Groups 75 feet.

PFF will fly lead and deputy lead in each Group. Bombing will be by visual means if possible. If smoke or cloud obscures target synchronous Pathfinder method will be used. Bombardier Mickey Operator teamwork is essential.

Method of attack: All Groups will fly close RIGHT echelon on route out.

465 and 464 will form close column of Groups over the Target. 485 will fly close RIGHT echelon on 465 and 464 from IP to Target so that both targets are hit simultaneously.

Care will be taken to avoid 16 HG just West of CRAIVO on route back.
