

OPERATIONS ORDER # 112

WEATHER ANNEX:

SYNOPTIC SITUATION 0700z

Small high over Azores with a wedge from this high extending over central Europe. Weak high over central Mediterranean. Deep low over British Isles with warm front running through north France into central France and cold front through northwestern France and Bay of Biscay.

FORECAST:

Base: Sky: Clear.

Air-Ground Visibility: 12 miles in haze.

Upper Winds: 5000' 300 degrees 20 knots.
10000' 300 degrees 25 knots.
15000' 300 degrees 30 knots.

ROUTE: Sky: Clear from base to northern Yugoslavia with scattered cumulus over Dinaric Alps. 4/10 to 5/10 middle clouds with bases at 14,000' and tops to 17,000' along Sava Rivier, increasing slightly to north. 3/10 to 5/10 high clouds with bases at 23,000'. Beginning in central Hungary.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 miles in haze.

Upper Winds: 10000' 290 degrees 25 knots.
15000' 280 degrees 30 knots.
20000' 270 degrees 30 knots.

TARGET: Sky: 5/10 middle cloud with base at 14,000' and tops at 17,000' to 18,000'. 4/10 high clouds with base at 23,000'.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 to 20 miles.

Upper Winds: 20000' 280 degrees 30 knots.
25000' 280 degrees 35 knots.

RETURN: No change except for slight increase in cumulus activity.

ALTERNATE FIELDS: All fields will remain open.

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
