BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 460th and 485th line rendezvous from ALTAMURA to GRAVINA 5,000 and 6,000 feet respectively. 460th on course at ALTAMURA 0712B. 465th assemble in assigned area. Wing Rendezvous 460th and 485th on course over SPINAZZOIA at 0722B. 465th falling immediately behind at 7,000 feet.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: To be signaled later.
