FIRST ALTERNATE TARGET: City of VIENNA by PF A/C. LAST RESORT TARGET: ZAGHEB and BROD M/Ys.

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 464th & 465th line rendezvous from ANDRIA to CANOSA at 7,000' and 3,000' respectively, 464th on course over ANDRIA at 0710 Baker. 460th & 485th line rendezvous from ALTANURA to FPAVINA at 9,000' and 10,000' respectively. 460th on course over ALTAMURA at 0713 Baker. Wing rendezvous: 464th & 465th over SPINAZZOIA on course at assigned altitudes at 0722 Baker. 460th and 485th fall in behind

464th & 465th over SPINAZZOTA at assigned altitudes arriving from the south at 0724 Baker.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: P-38s line rendezvous with Bombers between LAKE BALATON & GYOR for penetration, target & withdrawal Cover. P-47s provide penetration cover from IP, target & withdrawal cover. Groups P-51s execute maximum counter air force effort over target area intercepting bombers in vicinity of GYOR.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: Right echelon of Wings: 47th, 55th, (464, 465, 460, 485), 304th, 5th.
