 - b. (1) Normal effort of 2 groups each of B-17s of 5th Wing attack PARMA & MODENA M/Y at 1155 Baker, Key Point Time: 1100 Baker. Alternate Target: CRENONA, MANDUA, LEGNANO, and REGGIO EMELIA M/YS.
 - (2) Normal effort of 2 groups of B-17s of 5th Wing using AZON A/C attack FORNOVO DI TARO M/Y and OIL STORAGE at 1155 Baker. Key Point Tine: 1100 Baker.
 - (3) Normal effort of 4 groups of B-24s of 47th Wing attack UDINE m/Y, CASARSA and LATISANA RR BRIDGES at 1000 Baker. Key Point Time: 0954 Baker. Alternate Target: MONFALCONE shipyards and submarines in POLA HARBOR.
 - (4) Normal effort of 3 groups of B-24s of 49th Wing attack TRIESTE oil and storage at 1110 Baker. Key Point Time: 1004 Baker. Alternate Target: Same as 47th Wing.
 - (5) Normal effort of 4 groups of B-24s of 304th Wing attack Motor transports and repair depot at CHIVASSO and TURIN FIAT MOTOR WORKS at 1100 Baker. Alternate Target: VENTIMEGLIA and IMERIA M/YS.

LAST RESORT TARGET: Any active M/Y on PARMA-RIMINI line.

BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: 465th and 464th line rendezvous from ANDRIA to CANOSA at 6,000 feet and 7,000 feet respectively. 465th on course over ANDRIA at 0838 Baker.

460th and 485th line rendezvous from ALTAMURA to GRAVINA at 8,000 and 9,000 feet respectively. 460th on course over ALTAMURA at 0844 Baker.

Wing rendezvous: 465th and 464th over SPINAZZOLA on course at assigned altitudes at 0853 Baker. 460th and 485th approach from the South falling in behind 465th and 464th at assigned altitudes at 0855 Baker.

FIGHTER BOMBER RENDEZVOUS: To be signalled later.

ORDER OF FLIGHT: 3 columns of Wings: Left 304th Wing (West Coast). Center column: 55th Wing (465th, 464th, 460th, 485th), 5th Wing. Right column 47th and 49th Wings.

ROUTE OUT: SPINAZZOLA to MARGHERITA to $(42\ 00N\ -\ 16\ 20E)$ to Key Point $(44\ 10N\ -\ 13\ 40E)$ to $(44\ 48N\ -\ 12\ 22E)$ to IPs to targets.

Key Point Tine: 1024 Baker at 17,000 feet.

INITIAL POINT: 465th and 464th - PORTOMAGGIORE (44 42N - 11 49E).

460th and 485th - FORIIGNANA (44 51N - 11 52E).

AXIS OF ATTACK: 465th and 464th - 240 degrees. 460th and 485th - 230 degrees.

TARGET TDE: 1100 Baker.

BOMBING ALTITUDE: 465th - 20,000', 464th - 21,000', 460th - 19,000', 485th - 18,000'.

TARGET ELEVATION: 465th and 464th - 160 feet. 460th and 485th - 100 feet.

RALLY: 465th and 464th - Left. 460th and 485th - Sharp right and sweeping left.

ROUTE BACK: Rally to MARZABOTTO (44 21N - 11 12E) to COLBORDOLO (43 49N - 12 43E) to (43 40N - 14 25E) to (42 00N - 16 20E) to bases.

3. x. (1) 465th and 464th attack BOLOGNA MAIN M/Y using MPI as shown on inclosed target charts. Bomb Load same as Plan Able for 21 June 1944. Intervalometer settings: 40 feet.

- (2) 460th and 485th attack CASTEL MAGGIORE M/Y using MPI as shown on inclosed photographs. Bomb Load same as Plan Able for 21 June 1944. Intervalometer Setting: 50 Feet.
- (3) Formation will be close right echelon on route for maximum protection against fighters.
- (4) 460th and 485th will make an effort to fall in behind 465th and 464th on return route. 465th will maintain 150 MPH after rally until leaving coast to enable reforming of Wing.
- (5) 465th use PF A/C for navigational aid only.
- (6) Alternate attack units load 2 cartons window dispensing 6 units every 20 seconds from 1 minute before IP until clear of flak.
- (7) Do not bomb FLORENCE. No bombs will be dropped South of PISA-RIMINI line.
