OPERATIONS ORDER #104

WEATHER ANNEK:

SYNOPTIC SITUATION 1300Z

Small low over eastern Balkans with old occluded front approaching from north. Flat high cell over central Mediterranean.

FORECAST:

BASE: Sky: Clear.

Visibility: 20 miles or better.

Upper Winds: 5000' 270 degrees 15 knots,
10000' 270 degrees 10 knots.
15000' 270 degrees 20 knots.

ROUTE: Sky: Clear over Adriatic. 6/10 to 8/10 cumulus with tops at 11,000' over Yugoslav mountains, continuing to Craiova. 4/10 to 5/10 cumulus over Danube basin. 5/10 to 6/10 middle cloud and scattered high clouds over eastern half of route.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 miles.

Upper Winds: 10000' 280 degrees 15 knots.
15000' 290 degrees 20 knots.
20000' 280 degrees 25 knots.

TARGET: Sky: 3/10 to 5/10 low clouds at 6000' with tops to 14,000'. 5/10 to 6/10 middle clouds at 16,000'. 3/10 to 5/10 cirrus above 24,000'.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 to 20 miles.

Surface Wind: West to northwest at 5 to 10 mph.

Upper Winds: 20000' 270 degrees 25 knots.
25000' 270 degrees 30 knots.

RETURN: Cumulus over Yugoslav mountains up to 18,000' on return. 4/10 to 6/10 cumulus over bases at 5000'.

ALTERNATE FIELDS: All areas should remain open.
