WEATHER ANNEX:

SYNOPTIC SITUATION (1300Z):

Weak high pressure over eastern Mediterranean, Italy and central Europe with one center over Alps and another in the Gulf of Sidra, giving southwest to westerly flow aloft over southern and central Europe.

FORECAST:

BASE: SKY: Clear.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 miles.

Upper Winds: 5,000' 250 degrees 20 knots.

10,000' 250 degrees 30 knots.

15,000' 270 degrees 35 knots.

ROUTE: Sky: Clear from base to Yugoslavian coast with scattered middle clouds at 9,000'. 5 to 7/10 middle clouds tops 12,000, bases 9,000' with scattered low clouds from northern Yugoslavia, decreasing to 4/10 just north of Alps and then increasing again to 5 to 6/1c in target area.

Air-Ground Visibility: 15 to 20 miles decreasing to 10 to 12 miles to the north in haze.

Upper Winds: 10,000' 280 degrees 30 knots.

15,000' 290 degrees 30 knots.

20,000' 290 degrees 35 knots.

24,000' 270 degrees 35 knots.

TARGET: Sky: 5 to 6/10 middle, tops at 16,000', bases at 12,000'. 2/10 low clouds at 5 to 7,000'. 3 to 4/10 high above 24,000'.

Air-Ground Visibility: 10 to 12 miles in haze.

Upper Winds: 20,000' 260 degrees 30 knots.

25,000' 250 degrees 30 knots.

Surface winds from southwest, 8 miles per hour.

RETURN BASE: Generally clear with 3 to 4/10 middle clouds.

ALTERNATE FIELDS; All fields should be open.
